Project Description

The building will consist of a $25m \times 6$ lane pool, a $13m \times 7m$ learner pool with moveable floor, wet change village and gymnasium with separate changing facilities, an aerobics studio, 2no. 4 court sports halls with separate changing facilities and associated support space.

- · Complete the structural steel frame.
- Excavate the basement and pool.
- Concrete the main pool and learner pool tanks
- Brick and block work to the Sports Hall façade
- · Cladding to the building roof and sides
