Project Description

Our main elements of work in the forthcoming period are:

Piling

This will commence early September and continue until the end of October and is required due to ground conditions, we will have vibration monitoring equipment on site during this period.

Bulk Excavation & Hardcore Fill

We will be reducing levels on site which will mean tipper wagons coming back and forth. A road sweeper is available should the public highway become contaminated but we aim to avoid this by utilising the existing hardstanding on site, a wheel wash is also available. We will then be importing stone material to create a piling matt for the above mentioned works.

Culvert Diversion

The existing culvert is being diverted as the current one runs underneath the new building footprint. The environment agency have been notified and strict measures are in place to ensure no contamination occurs.

Tree Protection

There are a number of trees towards the back of site which are protected. We will be erecting a 'tree protection' fence and clearly marking out this area as a 'no go' for site operatives.

Questions & Answers

Will Beal lane always be open?

Yes – Beal lane will stay open for the duration of the project.

Where will contractors park?

Parking for construction workers is provided on site.

Will there be any noisy periods?


Noise will be kept to a minimum and we will notify you in advance via newsletter.
