#### Introduction

Welcome to the first Holdcroft Extra Care Project Newsletter.

We will send you regular updates like this to let you know what will be happening on site and provide you with more information on the different phases of the project.

Our construction partner, Eric Wright Construction, will be starting on site soon. They are associate members of the Considerate Constructors Scheme and are committed to ensuring our sites create as little disruption as possible while working in your area.

The new development will provide 175 self-contained one and two bedroomed apartments in two distinct but linked blocks around two central courtyards. It also has extensive communal facilities including a restaurant, library and fitness suite and is surrounded by landscaped gardens.

Construction is a maximum of three storey high and mainly traditional brickwork with double pitched tiled roofs on a mixture of piled and traditional foundations. The buildings are designed to meet BREEAM Excellent standards making them both energy efficient and environmentally friendly.
