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Project Description

The new Stockport Homes headquarters consists of four storeys of offices with basement parking. As you can see from the architects impression on the previous page the building is visually stunning whilst sympathetic to its surroundings and we are certain this high profile development will provide a new landmark for the residents of Stockport.

Upcoming Works

We are currently heavily into the groundworks forming a continuous piled structure around the perimeter of the site to allow excavation of the new basement. Whilst many of the techniques used in our operations give consideration to environmental impacts in terms of noise and vibration there will be on occasion minimal vibration that is monitored on site, so rest assured there is no need for alarm or concern for damage to your property. However, we do apologise in advance for any disruptions and we will endeavour to notify everyone should such a situation arise and my door is always open should you need to call me or call in to discuss.

We have quite a lengthy period of digging a big hole in the ground however things will become more interesting towards the end of April when a tower crane will be erected to assist with construction of the new steel frame.

Will there be any noisy periods? Minimal and within working hours only



Whilst excavating the site, a known historical windmill dating back to the 1700s was uncovered. Archaeologists painstakingly cleaned and surveyed the structure to update historical records. The circular base of the windmill is easily identified and several out buildings were uncovered which we are told would have housed a steam engine as technology progressed from wind power.
